EDUCATION

Essential resources to help children succeed.

Over 700 children attend our schools today. This year 73 have graduated from high school, and 5 are now in university, all from a community where most didn't finish primary school and only two people had ever graduated from high school.

- The new multipurpose dining hall is a large welcoming space where students can share meals, gather for assemblies, and celebrate together. But it is empty. We need tables and benches.
- We are getting Starlink internet! Adding a video projector would open the door to rich on-line learning.
- With the red clay and heavy rains, our campuses turn to mud. Pavers for the walkways would create clean, safe pathways to our beautiful new buildings.

HEALTH

Good health is the greatest gift of all.

Our rural Ugandan clinic is a lifeline for our students, staff, and more than 7,200 neighbors from 6 surrounding villages. Last year almost 2500 patients received care, 975 children were vaccinated, and 15 babies were delivered. To continue improving our medical services there are some essential items needed—supplies like malaria testing and treatment kits, a wheelchair, a trolley stretcher, a portable baby crib, and an fetal monitor. Together, we can extend Christ's love in tangible, life-giving ways to the families who depend on us

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

Partnering for community driven initiatives.

Our community development program strengthens locally led leadership teams by equipping them to design and implement their own sustainable development plans. These initiatives are funded through community savings groups, where members collectively save and invest. Eleven groups—totaling 290 members—have saved, loaned, and reinvested nearly \$15,000 over the past two years, enabling resiliency in the members and the launch of eleven group-owned businesses.

The community development team also collaborates with the clinic team to introduce health and sanitation initiatives, improving overall community well-being. Transportation is needed to help reach deep, rural locations.

Education transforms lives at every age. Our farm provides fresh crops and livestock to reduce school expenses while teaching income-generating skills to students and the community. Through our coffee project, we're building long-term sustainability, and this year we plan to plant an additional four acres of coffee.

Our Adult Literacy classes offer a priceless, second chance at education, and at our high school, every student learns a marketable vocational skill. Together, these initiatives nurture students, support families, and strengthen our communities.
