





Every child is created in the image of God, is valuable, and has a purpose.


Our village church is growing and thriving. This year, they would love to say goodbye to the dirt floors and unfinished walls inside of the building.

The Children’s Discipleship Programs include morning prayer and worship, weekly chapels, a high school youth club, Scripture Union Club, and Sunday School. A partner ministry, The Gospel Blaze, does upbeat and relevant outreaches to young people, and we have planned four area-wide gatherings with them in 2021 to impact the lives of youth.

EDUCATION

Equipped classrooms create success.

Between the primary and high school, over 600 children normally attend our schools, and about 50 teachers and staff are employed. Schools in Uganda are expected to be fully opened in 2020. The high school and primary school have both implemented new, more interactive curriculum, and new textbooks and supplies are needed.

Because practical skills for earning a living are crucial for the long-term success of our students, we are growing our vocational skills programs. We teach hairdressing, tailoring, and farming and want to add carpentry, brick laying, and animal husbandry. Costly supplies are needed for these important vocational programs.

INVEST IN EDUCATION

Education creates a path out of poverty.

Our new Multi-Purpose building, the largest gathering space in the district, will soon be completed for dining, assemblies, chapel, performances, and community gatherings. Kitchen supplies, tables, and chairs are needed to furnish it. Our lively music, dance, and drama program will practice and perform in it and would love costumes and instruments so they can pursue their goal of becoming a traveling dance troupe.

WATER, SANITATION & HYGIENE

The whole community benefits when children learn healthy habits.

In 2020, COVID brought us a reminder that good hygiene is crucial to health. The most basic tool for hygiene is soap & water. An adequate year-round water supply for the schools is something we are still working toward, and our state-of-the-art high school science lab has sinks waiting for water to supply them. A water harvesting and pumping system at the high school would increase supply and provide taps where water is needed. Additional hand-washing stations are also needed to make hand washing available at each building.

How can you help?

Help With Hygiene

- Month's supply of soap | \$35
- Hand-washing station (5) | \$100 each
- Water tanks (8) | \$650 each
- Gutters for water harvesting | \$750
- Solar powered pump | \$3500
- Elevated water tank and stand | \$5500

HEALTH

Good health is a priceless gift.

What if the nearest medical care was 12 miles away and you didn't have the \$3 it would take to hire a motorcycle to travel potholed, dirt roads to get there? That was the situation our community faced until we recently opened a community clinic that will serve an estimated 12,000 people from six villages. Once powered, our ultrasound machine will be the only one available to serve 250,000 people, and funds for an incinerator are needed to safely dispose of medical waste.

How can you help?

Give Improved Health

- One-month nurse's salary | \$100
- One-month medical supplies | \$250
- Generator to power the clinic and ultrasound machine | \$675
- Incinerator | \$1650





FOOD SECURITY & INCOME GENERATION

Empower our students and community.

We grow crops to decrease school expenses and to demonstrate innovative ways to generate income for the students and community. We have planted 290 fruit trees, 350 banana trees, 500 eucalyptus trees for timber, two acres of coffee plants, and 8 acres of maize for porridge at school. Pigs, goats, rabbits and one cow were introduced this year to provide fertilizers for the garden, improved nutrition for our students, and to demonstrate progressive animal rearing techniques. This year, we hope to add more animals and implement a drip irrigation system to safeguard harvests.

TRANSFORM FUTURES

God created us to flourish, but barriers like poverty hinder that.

Village Saving and Loan Associations (VSLA) have proven effective in combating poverty by providing members with the means to cope with emergencies, build capital, and create businesses that support genuine self-reliance. Through a training program developed by CARE International, we will equip trainers to implement saving circles throughout the area—empowering income generation projects which will also grow the local economy. A 10-day training program is planned for early 2021.
