Impact Highlights

EDUCATION

- 700 students enrolled in school from preschool through high school
- 85% of girls and 82% of boys passed the national high school exam
- 97% of primary school students stayed in school the whole year
- All high school students learned a vocational skill



WATER & SANITATION

- New 450,000-gallon reservoir will provide water for the school and community
- Completed the rainwater collection system in the primary school
- Installed a water purification system in the high school
- Handwashing training reduced typhoid cases by 44%



COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

- 21 adults started learning to read and write in the new adult literacy program
- 23 women established their first family businesses
- Savings groups grew by 200% and loaned over \$5,000 to start new businesses



SPIRITUAL GROWTH

- 149 people gave their lives to Jesus
- 101 students and community members were baptized in a baptismal service
- 70% of high school students participated in a daily student-led fellowship club



HEALTH

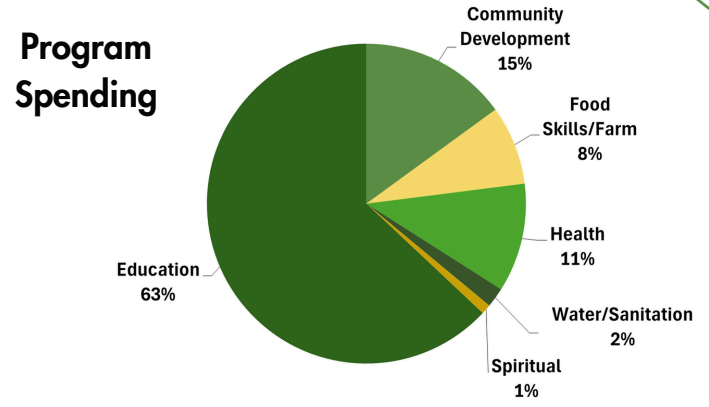
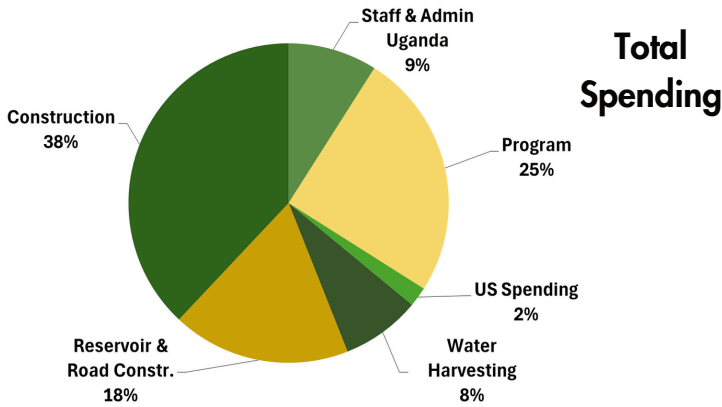
- 13 children fully recovered from malnutrition because of nutrition training

Education

- Increase high school enrollment
- Expand adult literacy program

Water and Sanitation

- Continue handwashing trainings and campaigns
- Install handwashing stations in the school

Community Development

- Expand vocational training and income generating opportunities for students and community members

Spiritual Growth

- Expand student fellowship club
- Create more community spiritual engagement opportunities

Health

- Reduce child malnutrition through screenings and education
- Conduct health trainings with all high school students



Impact Story: Santrinah

Santrinah is a student who is breaking barriers by going back to finish her education after giving birth at age 17. Now 20 years old, Santrinah has enrolled back in school but was having difficulty paying her school fees. HEED is now paying 85% of Santrinah's school fees to help support her in her dream of completing high school.

Santrinah is now glad she has hope to complete her education. "I dream of becoming a medical nurse. I had lost this opportunity, and I am grateful that God gave me a second chance through the scholarship program". She quotes Isaiah 55:11 that God's word is not in vain, emphasizing that she is sure that God will accomplish what He intends for her life.
